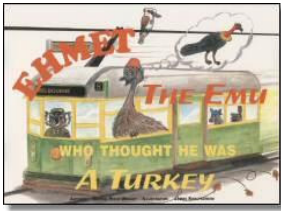

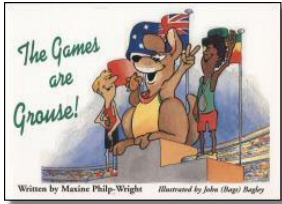
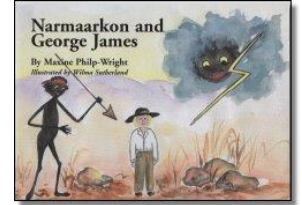


Ehmet the Emu who Thought He Was a Turkey (2nd Edition)

Narmaarkon is the lightning man from Arnhem Land and George James is the author's father who lived a traditional Life there over 70 years ago.

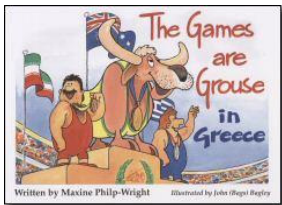
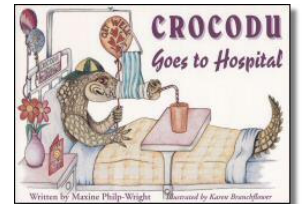


The Games are Grouse!

Crocodu, the crocodile from Kakadu National Park, is injured at the Cricket and has to go to Hospital. There he meets lots of other sick children and makes new friends.

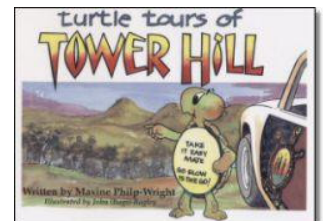

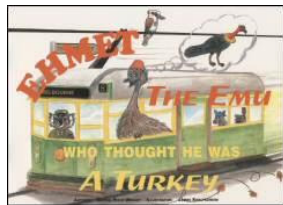
Maxine Elizabeth Philp-Wright was born in Wanganui, New Zealand and resided in Healesville, Victoria.
